There are between 1.5 and 2.5 cases of FAS per 1,000 live births in North Dakota each year.

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Causes of Mental Retardation in the U.S.

- Prenatal Alcohol Syndrome
- Downs Syndrome
- Fragile X Syndrome

FAS is the leading identifiable cause of mental retardation in the U.S.

Fetal Alcohol Syndrome

The full spectrum of damage caused by drinking during pregnancy is large. FAS represents only a part of this spectrum.

Prevalence of FAS in North Dakota

• 10-18 children with FAS are born each year.

The number of new cases of FAS appears to have been unchanged for several years.

Scope of the problem

- Populations of persons with FAS
- Children 180-324
- Adults 360-800

Depending on birth and death rates, the child and adult populations of people with FAS in North Dakota could be as high as 1124.

The average cost of Human Service System services is \$1,324.00 per year for each child with FAS.

In North Dakota the cost of Human Services for each case of FAS to the age of 18 is \$23,841.72.

The annual cost of medical care services was \$5,297.00 per case of FAS. In 1996-1997 the annual excess cost of medical care due to FAS was \$4,402.99 per case. In North Dakota the cost of inpatient medical care for each case of FAS to age 18 is \$95,034.60

Identified costs for FAS in North Dakota are at least 1.2 million dollars per year. The minimum cost estimate for the state of North Dakota to age 18 for each case of FAS is \$118,876.32.

For each \$10,000 spent caring for persons with FAS, North Dakota spent less than \$30.00 on prevention efforts.

Prevention of FAS

 If women who have had a child with FAS continue to drink, they have more than a 75% chance of having another child with FAS.

We must focus some prevention efforts on this very high risk group if we are to be effective in preventing FAS in North Dakota

If the state of North Dakota spent 1% of the cost of caring for persons with FAS on prevention, we would spend \$157,643 per year, or \$315,286.00 per biennium.
